TRIP POLICIES

In response to a clarified written policy, the following will be the guidelines for camping trips run by Camp White Meadow.

1) CAMP WHITE MEADOW TRIPS & PARENT'S PARTICIPATION

At the beginning of the camping season, a sign-up form will be sent home with the campers listing out the trips for all campers in groups Pre-K through 6th grade. Parents wishing to accompany their children on a specific trip must sign up for the trip by the date noted on the sign-up form. The Camp Director will review the requested list of participants and will notify the parents of their acceptance to participate. Parent participation will be allowed, but limited, according to the size of the group, bus size, etc. If the situation arises where there are more requests to go on a trip than space allows, a lottery with the parental names will take place.

All parents will be required to pay any admission charges or other charges associated with going on a trip.

Parents must understand that the trips and responsibility for the campers is that of the Camp White Meadow Supervisors on the trip and that they are there to help in chaperoning the group only. The Camp Supervisors and their Staff are the people in charge of the campers and parents must listen to the instructions of the Staff.

2) CAMP WHITE MEADOW POLICY FOR MISBEHAVING CHILDREN ON CAMP TRIPS

Campers not listening or acting within the stated guidelines of the Trip Supervisors will be reprimanded. We cannot allow misbehavior to jeopardize the safety and well being of our campers or staff. That penalty, which will be decided on as an as needed basis, may include the loss of a future trip. Repeated actions may be cause for dismissal from the camp program, without refunds. The Camp Staff will inform parents of actions that this policy would effect after the first infraction.
